PARENTS' EVENING APPOINTMENTS

The Form One parents were able to book their appointments this week and the bookings for the rest of the School will go live this Monday evening at 8.00pm. You should be sent a notification and then be able to open the App and select your desired day and time for each teacher that you need to see.

We are trying to ensure that all appointments keep to time and run as efficiently as possible. Parents are invited to arrive a few minutes early so that they can look through the books before the appointment starts. In order to maximise the time available, there is the option in the booking process to leave a comment for the teacher. If there is a particular question or concern that you have, please make sure you communicate this to the teacher prior to your appointment, either using this feature on the App or by emailing them direct.


