Dear Parents

PARENTAL FEEDBACK

Thank you to those of you who responded to last years 'parents survey'. We received 50 responses which were overall extremely positive. The survey told us that parents particularly appreciate the family-like and community feel at Rydes Hill, the small class sizes, our excellent teaching staff, and traditional values. Additionally, a large proportion of our parents commented on how happy their child is at Rydes Hill. Naturally, some common areas of improvement were identified which we have considered over the summer and are summarised below along with our actions.

- Feedback on child's progress and areas of development. For 2023-2024, our teaching staff have committed to ensure each parent is made aware of their child's areas for development and next steps, so everyone is aligned in their commitment to support each child. Parents should notice the first changes at the first Parent Consultation evening in October.
- Food quality and supporting children to make healthy choices. For 2023-2024 our catering team from Holroyd Howe have made some initial changes to the menu, and the food on offer to pupils will continue to evolve over this academic year and beyond. The most notable changes that can be seen immediately, is that all white flour-based items such as pasta and bread have been switched to wholewheat and white rice has been replaced with brown rice. There is a heavier focus on fruit for pudding, with both whole fruit and fruit salad being on offer daily. November marks the National Veg Pledge and World Vegan Day, so the catering team will be marking these events with tasting tables to encourage our pupils to try new and exciting vegetables, as well as testing some new vegetarian and vegan recipes. We are also in discussion with our milk supplier to switch to organic milk.
- Inconsistent communication. For 2023-2024, we intend on launching a new 'parents page' on our website that will contain a notice board for the current and upcoming week, with confirmed details of activities including required uniform etc. The parents page will also include a revised and interactive parents e-handbook which will be completely up to date and will include information on our policies, procedures, uniform lists etc. Teaching staff will be given a checklist before the start of each term to ensure that they have communicated everything that is required in a timely manner.

Thank you again, for your openness, positivity, and constructive feedback. We intend on running the parents survey again in the summer term. If you have any feedback that you'd like to share before then you are encouraged to do so. THE HUB

Over the summer, a great deal of work has been done to strip out the old, rather outdated computing suite, and replace it with a space that we hope will inspire, motivate and enable our children to explore the digital world. There has been great debate about what to call this room; we will be teaching a STEAM curriculum (Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and Maths) that will extend beyond this room and into the classrooms. However, a STEAM room had connotations of a spa! We have instead settled on 'The Hub'. We have brand new iPads, laptops, a green screen, robots, desks and seating that are flexible and allow children to choose how best to learn. Still to come are white boards for design on the walls. This will used by children across the School, and we hope they will be coming home talking about the exciting lessons they have there. The Hub will be on show at our Open Morning on 8th October, so do go up and have a look at the changes. We would like to thank the FRHPS for their fundraising for the set of MARTY robots, and a very generous Alumnus for her donation of £3000 towards The Hub.

CAR PARK SAFETY

Please can parents remember the speed limit on our site is 5mph.
