







Dear Parents

HAPPY NEW YEAR!

We would like to wish all our families a happy and healthy New Year. We hope you had a relaxing break. Thank you for all your generous gifts and kind words at the end of last term. Thank you, also, to anyone who has informed us that your child was COVID positive during the holidays. We are asked to record these numbers, but it also helps us for future planning to know how many children have already tested positive and when.

We are very pleased to welcome two new members of staff to Rydes Hill this term. Mrs Faye Messinger has joined us as Head of Nursery. She is also a member of the Senior Leadership Team. Mrs Georgie McEnery has been a volunteer Teaching Assistant in Upper Transition on a Monday and she is now a permanent member of staff. Mrs Appleby no longer has regular hours at Rydes Hill, but you will still see her around as she will be available to cover for us when we have staff absences. Mr Rob will retire at the end of January and we will thank him in Assembly on Friday 28th January. I am aware that the Class Reps are organising a collection for a gift for him.

At the time of writing, four members of staff are isolating (including me!) However, we anticipate that this may well change, and contingency plans are in place if large numbers of staff are required to isolate. As we have done since the start of the pandemic, we will aim to ensure that children receive exactly the same high-quality lessons as usual. There may need to be some timetable changes and, should this be the case, we will communicate this with parents at the earliest opportunity.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS

The Calendar of Events was sent out to all families prior to Christmas. There are a couple of minor changes. Swimming has resumed this week, which means that the final lesson of the term will be Thursday 24th / Friday 25th March. The Netball Tournament planned for Saturday 29th January has been postponed until later in the term. Parents Forum will now take place on Thursday 24th February at 7.30pm. Finally, the times given for Parents' Evening on 29th and 31st March are slightly incorrect. The times are 5-7pm on 29th and 4-6pm on 31st. The meetings on 31st will be held on Zoom. Sorry for any inconvenience caused.

OPEN CLASSROOMS

All parents are warmly invited to come into School with their child on the afternoon of Thursday 20th January between 3.30-4.30pm to look at your child's work and to see the classroom. This is a lovely opportunity for your child to show you what they have been doing and to share their work. Teachers may be in and out of classrooms, getting ready for the next day. Please remember that this is not a Parents' Evening and if you have things that you need to discuss with the teacher, please make a separate appointment. Please ensure you have had a negative LFD before arriving in School.

The children have been very excited to meet Cody this week. He came into Assembly on Monday and has been joining children in Forest School and Computing lessons. Mrs Morris is training Cody to be a School Dog. As he gets older, he will receive further training from an accredited professional. 
TRAIN TO TEACH

The New Year often creates an opportunity for us to take time to reflect on our aspirations and sometimes this may lead to a decision to change career. Teaching is a wonderful occupation, whether it is your first career or one that you come to later in life, with a little life experience and wisdom under your belt. At Rydes Hill we are very proud to work with St Polycarp's School as a teacher training provider. Later this month, they are hosting two virtual events on Tuesday 25th and Thursday 27th January and will be talking through the different routes into teaching, and explaining a bit more about the programme they offer. COVID UPDATES

Anyone who tests positive on a Lateral Flow test no longer needs to have a PCR. They need to isolate immediately and follow the stay at home guidance. Anyone with one of the three main symptoms of COVID (Loss or change to taste or smell / raised temperature / new or persistent cough) should book a PCR test and isolate until the result is known. If you receive a positive COVID result, either from LFD or PCR, you should isolate at home. Current guidance is in the flowchart below. However, since this was sent to us last Monday, it is almost out of date as the guidance changes this Monday 17th January. From this date, the isolation period is reduced. You must isolate for a minimum of 5 full days. If you get a negative LFD result on days 4 and 5, you may leave isolation on day 6.
