#### **PARENTS IN SCHOOL**

#### **PUFFER COATS**

The Second Hand Uniform Shop has a number of puffer coats in the larger sizes. Smaller sizes are a little harder to come by, but if any are donated these will be put straight onto ParentMail so that you can order them. We will need to find an alternative to the puffer coat as Valentino are no longer able to stock them. This will be discussed at Parent Forum this term.

#### **CLARITY OVER UNIFORM**

There is some confusion over what children should wear into School in the mornings, especially if they come into School wearing PE kit on. The following rules apply:

- If children are in uniform, they should wear a blazer or puffer. Girls should wear their boater (summer) or beret (winter).
- If children are in PE kit, they do not need to wear their blazer or boater / beret **unless** there is Mass that day, in which case children will need their blazer and girls will need white ribbons in their hair

I will be carrying out a uniform check in the coming weeks, including checking that uniform items are labelled with the child's name. We have ongoing issues with children not taking the previous name out of second hand uniform and expecting everyone to know who it now belongs to, so please make sure you remove old name tags. The class with the most correct uniform will get an extra playtime on the Adventure Playground.
