FOUNDER'S DAY CONCERT

Thank you to all the girls who performed in the fantastic Founder's Day concert last Friday. The standard was incredibly high and it was wonderful to have an 'in person' performance. Despite the lockdowns and disruptions it is really clear that everyone has carried on working very hard and making amazing progress. COVID UPDATE

We currently have a large number of staff off with COVID, but only one or two children. Today marks the end of the Government's free testing programme and they have sent through to all schools the following recommendations:

- adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature
- children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days

ADMINISTERING MEDICATION IN SCHOOL

Our First Aid policy states that staff in School should not administer non-prescription medication such as paracetamol (calpol). This is a Department for Education regulation. We have sent a separate communication about this but the School Office is still repeatedly being asked to administer paracetamol to children. Please speak to me if you have any questions or concerns about this rule.

SPANISH

Mme Hopgood, our French teacher, is also fluent in Spanish and is keen for children at Rydes Hill to have as much experience of languages as possible before they go to Senior School. At present, Higher Prep and Form One have two French lessons per week. In the Summer term we will trial them having one lesson of French and one of Spanish each week. We will review this at the end of the term before making a decision about what we will offer from September. Any parents with a view on this are encouraged to share it in the Parents' Forum meeting in the Summer term.

As we move into Summer Uniform next term, please make sure your child has their PE flash on their skort / shorts. Additional / new flashes can be purchased from the School Office for £2.
