Thank you to everyone who made our wonderful Christmas Fair on Sunday possible. It was lovely to see the School Community coming together for fundraising and fun! A special thank you to all the Friends Committee for their hard work, especially Mrs Yusuf, Mrs Hopkin and Mrs Tyler and all the parents who helped with setting-up, running the stalls and tidying up afterwards. Early indications show that £6,000 has been raised with match funding and volunteer donations, which is more than enough to cover the cost of the floodlights for the tennis courts.

EXTENDING STAY AND PLAY HOURS

Mrs Cheyne will join us to take over from Mrs Ellis as Head of Housekeeping. She will also work in Stay & Play all week.
