#### **COVID UPDATE**

The number of cases locally continues to remain high and we are seeing an increasing number of cases in School. When there is a positive case in a class, parents are informed via ParentMail. Under the current regulations, close contacts who have been double vaccinated or are under the age of 18 years 6 months are advised to take a PCR test. Children who display one of the three COVID symptoms (high temperature, new continuous cough or loss or change to their sense of smell or taste) will need to go for a PCR test and isolate until the result is known. If parents choose not to take their child for a PCR test, we have to assume that they are positive, and they must isolate for ten days. For children who do test positive, the isolation period and return date are set by NHS Test and Trace, not by school. This will vary based on the date that the symptoms started. I understand that there are a number of parents who are concerned about the rise in cases, especially as the control measures are more relaxed. We are trying to have Whole School Assembly outside or on Zoom where possible, and children sit with children from their class only at lunch. If parents have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me.

#### **OPEN MORNING**

We are excited to have over 45 families booked in for our Open Morning tomorrow. Thank you to the Form One and Higher Prep girls who are coming in to help out and show prospective families what Rydes Hill has to offer. If anyone knows of families who are looking for a Nursery or Reception place in 2022 and they have missed the Open Morning, please encourage them to book in for a tour.

#### WINTER UNIFORM

Please remember that all children should be in Winter Uniform from today. If you have been unable to get a puffa coat that fits your child, a warm, plain coloured (ideally navy or red) coat is acceptable. We are in the process of sourcing a replacement for the puffa. Some samples have arrives at School and Mrs Norville will have these at the gate each morning next week. Parents will be able to give their views via a ParentMail survey.

We had originally planned for Lower Transition to lead us in our Harvest Assembly celebrations this year.
