ANNUAL REMINDERS

Please remember that we have a number yew trees in the grounds. These berries ripen between September and November and are poisonous if eaten. All children are reminded of the Forest School Rules (no picking, no licking) but we encourage parents to remind their children at home to reinforce this message.

Please also remember that children need to be closely supervised in the car park. Drivers are asked to be particularly careful when approaching the zebra crossing, as it is not always easy to see that there are pedestrians waiting, and when reversing.

SCHOOL PUFFA COATS

We have been contacted by Valentino, our uniform suppliers, to tell us the company that was providing our puffa coats has suddenly informed them that they are no longer able to produce them. They have tried, in vain, to find an alternative supplier.
