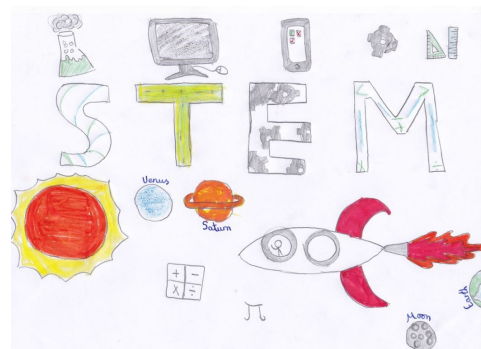
## PARENT CONSULTATION MEETINGS
