ODD SOCKS / FUNKY TIGHTS DAY

Next Monday, 16th November marks the start of Anti-Bullying week. All children are invited to wear odd socks or funky tights with their school uniform on Monday to celebrate the fact that we are all different. The children will hear about Anti-Bullying week in assembly and there will be activities taking place in PSHCE lessons.

PARENTS' FORUM

Thank you to everyone who attended (virtually!) the Forum on Tuesday. Notes on the points covered will be sent to all parents today. Discussion took place about School Uniform and it was agreed by those present that clarity was needed on what the rules for uniform are. The following summarises what should be worn in Main School:

- On a PE or Forest School day, children should wear PE kit, a puffa coat and (if needed) a beanie hat.
- On all other days, children should wear winter uniform and a puffa coat. Girls should wear their blue beret.
- All hair accessories should be navy blue. Scarves should be plain navy blue or bottle green. Hats should be the blue beret or the School beanie.

The teachers and I will be checking uniform each morning so please do make sure your child has the correct items. The Second Hand Uniform has a number of items in excellent condition, so do check stock levels there if there is anything you need (see below).

WELL VENTILATED ROOMS

One of the regulations that we are given by the Government is that our rooms need to be well ventilated, with doors and windows left open. We have been blessed with some milder weather recently but it will get colder. Children are encouraged to wear warm layers under their uniform (vest / base layer) to keep warm. Children may bring a plain navy or plain bottle green fleece into School to wear in class over their uniform. We have been trying to source these to purchase in bulk but this is proving tricky so it would be easier and quicker for parents to order their own online if they would like their child to have one.

SECOND HAND UNIFORM

A huge thank you to Mrs Lamont, Ms O'Neill, Mr Mick and Mr Rob for their amazing work in the Second Hand Uniform Shop. The quality of the items in the Shop is fantastic, with most items in new or nearly new condition. It is always worth checking the Shop first when you need something before going to Valentino. Now that we have our wonderful hanging rails we are in need of child sized hangers, including ones with clips for trousers or skirts. If anyone has any spare hangers, please send them into School with your child.

ONLINE SAFETY

At Rydes Hill we want to make sure our pupils are safe when working online. To achieve this, we have robust filters in place to ensure the content the pupils see is safe and age appropriate. To develop this further, we are introducing a safer way to search for information online. Swiggle is a child friendly, advert free, search engine from the online safety experts at SWGfL (South West Grid for Learning).

Swiggle has been designed to support young children when searching for images or content online and so is very user friendly. Having Swiggle as a school or home search engine page for young children ensures their search environment is safer; safer to experiment with different search strings; safer to browse image or content results. It's a safe sandpit to develop those skills before progressing on to more open and transparent online search engines like Google or Bing.
