It was with a great deal of pride that I accompanied our Higher Prep and Form One swimmers to the IAPS National Swimming Finals at the London Aquatics Centre on Saturday. If we were proud of them before we started, we were bursting with it by the time we left! The girls represented Rydes Hill amazingly. Scarlett T (HP) swam in the U10 25m butterfly, placing 7th in her heat and 13th overall. The relay team (HP – Scarlett T, Lakita T, Chloe R and Izzy R F1 – Olivia C, Sophie S, Hannah L, Lilia H and Temisha V) performed amazingly, swimming 8x25m in a personal best time of 2.17. We were so glad that Lilia could come along to the event, despite being unable to swim after breaking her arm following qualification. Well done to Temisha for stepping in. The girls worked superbly as a team and their efforts paid off, resulting in third place and a bronze medal! Well done to all those who came to support the team, most especially Mrs Sparks who ably coached the team on the day and Mrs Morris for training the team before the event.
