Our Annual Easter Egg Raffle takes place on Friday 22nd March. Tickets are 50p each and can be purchased in cash via class teachers or in bundles of 4 tickets on the ParentMail shop. BAKE SALE MONDAY 18th MARCH AT LUNCHTIME

We will be trying something new for the Bake Sales this term. Lower Transition's Bake Sale will take place on Monday 18th March, but it will happen during lunchtime. There are two options for how children are able to buy a cake. They can either bring in £1 on the day of the sale and hand it to their class teacher in the morning. Alternatively, parents can



choose to pay via the ParentMail shop. However, they should be aware that this will cost £2 as this is the minimum spend on ParentMail. The cut off for purchasing cakes is 8.20am on Monday morning. Each child will only be allowed to buy one cake and anyone who does not bring in money or has not paid on ParentMail will not get a cake. We will see how this way of doing Bake Sales goes and review for the remainder of the term.
