SUMMER TERM

PROTOCOLS FOR ONLINE LEARNING

All parents have been sent our Rydes Hill protocols for online / remote learning. Please read these through and share the 'pupils' section with your child. Children in Lower Transition to Form One have been set up with an email address. Usernames and passwords will be sent to parents this weekend. Please do try to make sure your child can log in prior to term starting on 23rd April. If you have any questions, please contact your child's class teacher in the first instance.

INSET DAY

The School had planned on having an Inset Day on Wednesday 22nd April. We will be closed next Wednesday to enable all staff to be fully prepared for the start of the Summer term and for remote teaching and learning.

SHOWBIE

To support your child's home learning, we will be using an application called 'Showbie' which is an app used by teachers to assign, collect, and review student work. The children will be able to download and edit documents sent by their class teacher and then upload for marking. Alternatively, the children can provide responses to assignments or annotate worksheets directly in the app in the form of text comments, the pen tool (which allows them to draw and write directly on the page) and pinned voice notes. They can also submit work to Showbie from other applications such as Microsoft Word and Power Point.



Likewise, teachers can provide grades as well as feedback in the form of voice notes, annotations, and videos.

Showbie can be accessed for free via the app store on an Apple device or by visiting my.showbie.com on a personal computer. We will issue each child with their own username and password so they can sign into their account which has already been created by their class teacher. We will also issue instructions on how to access Showbie for the first time. In due course, we will also be inviting parents to create a Showbie account so they can view and track their child's work. Please wait for the class teacher to send you the class code for you to link your account.
