CHANGES TO LUNCH SERVICE

As we move to a more 'normal' world, after Easter we will return to buffet service for the children at lunchtimes. This will mean that children can select the food that they would like. Rather than a full salad bar, children will be able to choose pots of crudites with their meal and bread and soup will return as an option for those who would like it. Children will still eat in their 'bubbles' and plates will be cleared for them to avoid children walking around the dining hall. We would like to continue the ParentMail forms where parents give a preference for the meal their child will be served. This has significantly reduced the amount of wastage each day, and we would like to keep wastage to a minimum. The choice you make on the form will give an indication to the kitchen of what to cook, but there will still be choice for children on the day.

PARENTS' FORUM MEETING

The meeting for the Summer term will take place on Tuesday 20th April at 2pm. The focus of the meeting will be to introduce the Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) curriculum that is taught across the School in the Summer term. For the vast majority of the School, the emphasis is most definitely on relationships, with the focus on understanding that we are all unique and special, understanding families, friendships and loving relationships. In Higher Prep, puberty is taught and in Form One the girls are taught about creating new life. The programme we use is called 'Journey in Love' and it is one of the approved programmes for use in this Diocese. There will be more detail given at the meeting, along with an outline to changes in legislation relating to SRE and how this is being addressed in School. Parents of Form One pupils will also receive a separate letter about the content of their curriculum before the lessons begin in the summer term. If anyone has any questions or concerns ahead of the meeting, please do not hesitate to ask me.
