MOVING ON AFTERNOON

We are very excited for the children to meet their new teachers and see their new classrooms on Monday. We are also looking forward to welcoming parents at the end of the day, to meet the teacher(s) and hear about the year ahead. Moving On Afternoon is always logistically challenging, but with over 40 new joiners in September (24 in Nursery, 18 in Main School), there are some logistical challenges! You will have been sent a ParentMail with information for you child's class. Below is a summary, which hopefully will help!

Current Class	New Class	Parental arrangements on Monday
Oaks	Kindergarten	Parents to collect children from Nursery as usual at the end of the day. No parent meeting as this has already taken place.
Kindergarten	Lower Transition	Parents to attend Welcome Meeting at 3pm in the Lower Transition classroom. Come in through the Main Entrance to register and you will be directed to the classroom. Parents who are unable to attend may collect at 3.15pm or from Stay & Play as usual.
Lower Transition	Upper Transition	Parents to attend Welcome Meeting at 3pm in the Upper Transition classroom. Come in through the Main Entrance to register and you will be directed to the classroom. Parents who are unable to attend may collect at 3.15pm or from Stay & Play as usual.
Upper Transition	Lower Prep	Parents to collect children from outside the Middle Prep door (near the outdoor bookcase) at 3.15pm. No parent meeting as this has already happened.
Lower Prep	Middle Prep	Parents to attend Welcome Meeting at 3.10pm in the Middle Prep classroom. Come in through the Middle Prep door and go straight to the classroom. Parents who are unable to attend may collect at 3.30pm or from Stay & Play as usual.
Middle Prep	Higher Prep	Parents to attend Welcome Meeting at 3.10pm in the Higher Prep classroom. Come in through the Science Lab door and go straight to the classroom. Parents who are unable to attend may collect at 3.30pm or from Stay & Play as usual.
Higher Prep	Form One	Parents to attend Welcome Meeting at 3.10pm in the Form One classroom. Come in through the Main Entrance to register and you will be directed to the classroom. Parents who are unable to attend may collect at 3.30pm or from Stay & Play as usual.

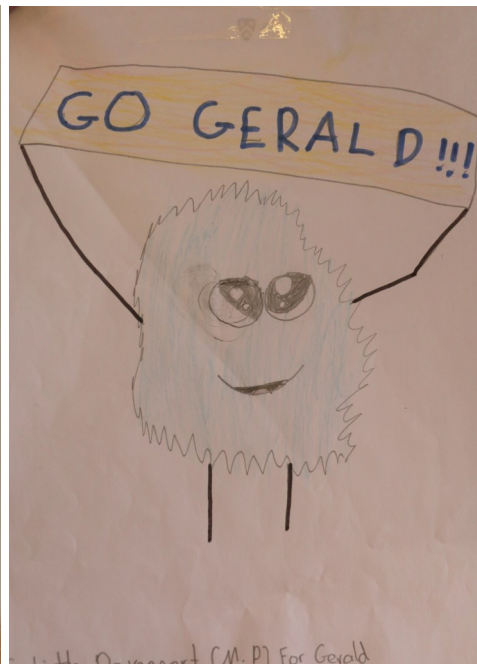
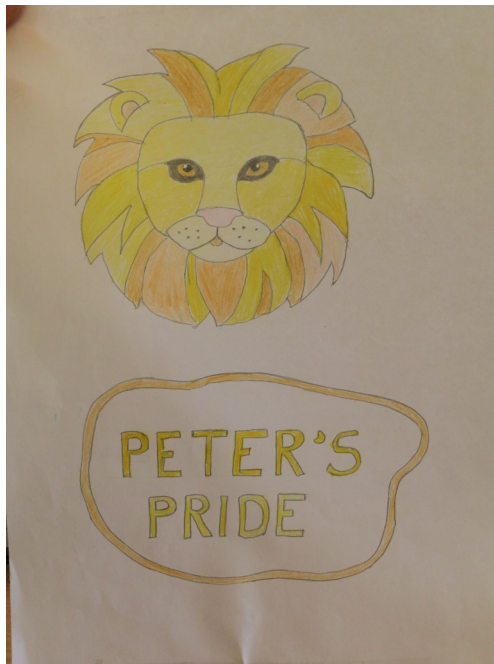
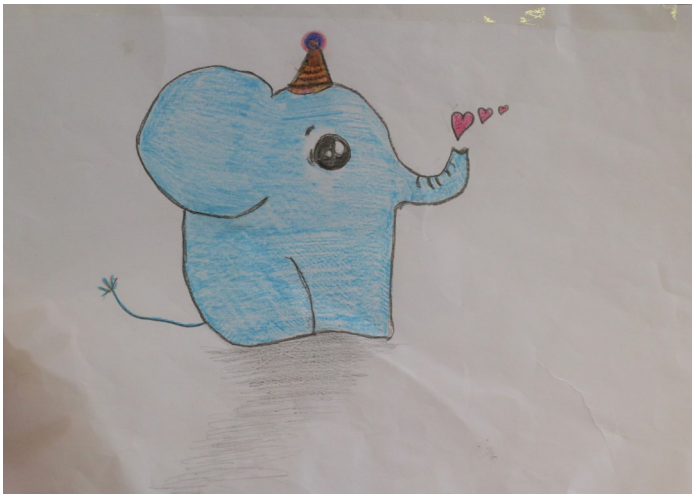
