RYDES HILL'S GOT TALENT

RELATIONSHIPS SEX AND HEALTH EDUCATION (RSHE)

All year groups in School cover RSHE. This is a mandatory subject that must be taught in all schools. At Rydes Hill we follow one of the programmes of study approved by the Catholic Diocese of Arundel and Brighton, 'Journey in Love'. In the vast majority of classes, the lessons focus on relationships and health. We only cover sexual intercourse in the lessons taught to Form One. All classes will be taught the 'Journey in Love' programme in the Summer term.
