NEW TERM NEW NORMAL

Welcome back to the start of the summer term. I hope you all had a restful and enjoyable Easter break. I sincerely hope that this term will bring with it not just some warmer weather, but a chance to move to more normal times! We have put the Calendar of Events for the remainder of the year together, in the optimistic hope that many of the events will take place, but there are already some changes that I need to announce:

Coffee mornings pre 17th May – in order to allow more parents to attend, the two mornings scheduled prior to 17th May will be moved to later in the term. Lower Prep and Middle Prep now Friday 28th May; Nursery and Kindergarten Friday 18th June.

75th Anniversary Event – with a very heavy heart we have taken the decision to cancel this event. We are concerned that inviting such a large number of people to come to School, many of whom fall into vulnerable categories, is not a good idea. The FRHPS will plan a summer event for current parents and we will be scheduling tours of the School for alumni during weekends over the summer. More details to follow!

Events with parents on site – we are hoping that the major events of the summer term, including Sports' Day, the Summer Production and Prize Giving, will be able to take place with parents on site. The decision on this will be dictated by the Government guidance and infection rates at the time. In any event, it is likely that a maximum of two people per child will be able to attend. **All adults attending will be required to show evidence of a negative lateral flow device** (LFD) test on arrival. More details on this will be provided nearer the time. However, if you are not already completing twice weekly home testing, it would be a good habit to get into! Tests are available to all adults, free of charge, and can be collected from the test centres at Onslow Park and Ride car park and the University of Surrey Cark Park 1 between 2.30-8pm each day.
