TREE UPDATE

ESSA Swimming Gala—Saturday 11th May

Lakita T, Hannah L, Izzy R and Scarlett T went through to compete in the South East Primary Schools Team Championships at Spectrum. We were entered in the small schools relays. The standard is very high, incredibly competitive and our girls did very well in the semi-finals going through to the finals securing 6th place overall with their best, most impressive time being 1.08.46. Last year's winning time was 1.06.78 and this year's winning time was 1.03.62 for Windlesham showing how the level of competition has risen. We finished 8th in the overall small mixed 4 x 25m mixed stroke relay with a time of 1.20.91. Unfortunately we were disqualified on one of our takeovers.
