
#### **VAT ON FEES**

#### **PARENT CONSULTATIONS**

#### **MEASLES**

You will no doubt have seen a great deal in the media recently about the low level of immunisation against measles in the UK at the moment. We have several vulnerable children, siblings of vulnerable children and vulnerable staff in School. I would like to risk assess how best to protect them. I will be sending out a survey on ParentMail for you to complete to indicate whether your child has had both doses of the MMR, or the equivalent Measles vaccination. This is an anonymous survey, but it would be very helpful if you could complete it so that we can gauge the level of immunisation in our School.

#### LOST PROPERTY

Mrs Mansi has kindly offered to put all our lost property out on display once a month for parents to look through

and collect what is theirs. The first of these will happen on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> January between 3pm-4pm. The tables will be under the shelter in the Kindergarten playground. Mrs Mansi will have a fabric marker on hand so that you can immediately put a name in anything that is yours. Should an unnamed item be left in lost property for a month, it will be transferred to the second hand uniform shop. To be absolutely clear, <u>every item of uniform should be</u> <u>clearly labeled with your child's name</u>. For the red school coat, please attach the name label to the fleece lining side of the coat, at the collar. The best examples of name labels are where the label can be sewn in to also act as a hook for the coat (please see example).



#### **SNACKS AT BREAK TIME**

We have some children who bring huge snacks for break time and this means that they do not eat their lunch. All break snacks should be small (in a named box with a lid no bigger than 10cm<sup>2</sup>) Children may bring fruit, vegetables, plain crackers or plain bread sticks. Children should not bring things in plastic bags or packets. Thank you.
