We were blessed with beautiful weather on Wednesday, 24th May when we went to District Athletics at Guildford Spectrum. Six girls were selected for each age group to take part in a Quadkids Athletics competition. This involves each child doing a short sprint, long run, vortex throw and long jump and scoring points for their school. The following eight schools were competing;

Guildford High School (GHS), St Catherine's, St Hilary's, Tormead, Manor House, Rowan, Rydes Hill, St Teresa's.
