SLOW RETURN TO NORMALITY

It has been lovely to slowly and confidently take a few more steps towards School life as we know it! The Bake Sale on Monday was a great success; thank you to the parents who baked and volunteered. This week we have also had our first 'face to face' event for Parents. Higher Prep parents met with School staff to discuss the process for applying to Senior Schools and had the opportunity to ask questions. This was very successful and it was lovely to be able to see people in person rather than just on a screen. Thank you to all the parents who attended and took their Lateral Flow Device (LFD) tests prior to arrival. This gives us all the confidence that a return to a more normal way of life will be as safe as possible.

The whole project should be finished and ready to use this September. Following last week's message requesting volunteers to take over the Chair and Treasurer roles for the Friends from September, here is some information on what the roles entail, as many of you have not yet had the chance to attend an event run by the Friends;

• The Chairs run the Committee meetings (2 per term), which are informal and short (no more than an hour), where events are planned and fundraising ideas discussed. Meetings are currently on Zoom, so they are easy to attend, and when restrictions permit, will be held in person at School (with wine and biscuits!) and Zoom.

• The Chairs oversee the planning and running of fundraising events (1 per term) - Christmas Fair, Quiz Night and Summer Fair. They receive help and support from Class Reps and other parents and all events are tried and tested and straightforward to run.

• The Treasurer manages the Friends bank accounts and provides financial updates to the Committee. The current Treasurer, Nicole Li, has given us the following quote," "The role of Treasurer is an important responsibility but, I promise, not as daunting as it might at first look. In fact on the contrary, it has been a very enjoyable role and with excellent support from the rest of the Friends and of course the wonderful Mr Parr (Deputy Bursar of the School). The role is a great way to get more involved with school life and make new friends with parents in other year groups. We will also need a few volunteers to take over as Class Reps - your current Class Reps will be in touch about this. As well as attending meetings and helping at events, in normal times Class Reps also organise social events (class dinners, dads'/mums' drinks etc), so it's a great opportunity to get involved and get to know your class better!




