PARENTS' EVENING BOOKINGS

Booking for Parents' Evening will go live tonight (**Friday 7th October**) at **8pm**. Booking is on a first come, first served basis and all appointments are face-to-face. The meetings will take place on Tuesday 18th and Thursday 20th October. There are additional sessions for Nursery as there are so many children. Each appointment is for 10 minutes and you will meet with your child's Form Teacher to discuss progress to date and targets for the year ahead. Books / classwork will be available for you to see and the appointments will take place in your child's classroom. Parents of children in Form One will also have the option of booking a follow up appointment with Mrs Norville to discuss Senior School options. This is only necessary if you need reassurance about the choices previously discussed, or if there is anything new to add. These appointments can be booked through the same ParentMail system.

OPEN MORNING

We look forward to welcoming families to our Open Morning tomorrow 10am-12noon. We have 40 families booked to attend, along with 40+ existing families. On arrival, please register in the Entrance Hall so that we know that you are here. Children in Higher Prep and Form One who are helping with the Open Morning need to come in uniform and can be dropped off at 9.45am and collected at 12noon. Younger children can wear home clothes and need to be accompanied by an adult. We would like existing parents who are on site to wear a Rydes Hill sticker so that prospective parents can approach them to ask questions, if they would like an 'insider' viewpoint.

HEARING YOUR CHILD READ

One question that I am frequently asked is, "what can I do to help support my child's learning?" One of the most helpful things parents can do is hear their child read at home. Even fluent readers would benefit from reading aloud to an adult once or twice a week. For our Pre-Prep children, class teachers can very easily tell who is reading at home every night and who isn't, as it is clear from their reading levels and the speed at which they progress. The reading books the children bring home have lots of tips on how to ask your child questions to ensure that they have understood what they have read, which is vital. A child may be able to read a sentence fluently, but this doesn't necessarily mean they have understood it. If you are having difficulties with any aspect of hearing your child read at home, please speak to your child's teacher.





