Eloise was diagnosed with a very rare brain tumour at 18 months old and given a 10-20% chance of surviving. Due to pioneering surgery, the tenacity of her parents and medical team to get the best possible follow up treatment and the sheer determination of Eloise and her family, the tumour was removed, and she has shown no evidence of disease for two years. At the time of diagnosis, it was thought that she would not reach her 2nd birthday. If she could reach her 4th birthday, her chances would rise to 90%. This week has definitely been a cause for huge celebration! We were very pleased to host Eloise's party at School on Sunday, and I would like to thank all our School Family for coming together to help this very special and inspirational little girl celebrate a monumental milestone.
