

All Year-Round Nursery Fees

The Nursery day runs from 7.30am to 6pm, Monday to Friday with a choice of 3 sessions. Breakfast is served at 7.30am, lunch at 12 noon and afternoon tea at 5pm:

•	7.30am to 6pm - includes breakfast lunch and a light supper	£73.50*
•	7.30am to 1pm - includes breakfast and lunch	£37.50
•	12.45pm to 6pm – includes lunch and afternoon a light supper	£37.50

NB: Early Years Funding credits/stretched funding have not been reflected in the above daily rates. We are able to accept Childcare Vouchers.

*With funding the estimated discount is £10.85, depending on the start date. This brings the daily rate down to approximately £62.65.

All Year-Round Nursery Calendar

Our Nursery is open 48 weeks of the year, except 8 Bank Holidays and 1 staff training day in September. It will be closed on:

- Bank Holidays
- Approximately 10 days in the summer
- Approximately 5 days at Easter
- Approximately 5 days at Christmas
- For one Inset day in September for staff training

The Nursery closure dates for 2019 are captured overleaf.

Parents have the option to take 10 additional days (2 weeks) at any time of the year outside of the fixed Nursery closed dates. This will be pro-rated according to your child's full-time Nursery start date and the year runs from September to August. There is no charge for these optional 10 days. This allows parents to benefit from cheaper holidays outside of the school holiday periods).

Is There a Minimum Number of Sessions?

The minimum number of sessions you may book is 4 half day sessions or 2 full day sessions.
