## PARENT CONSULTATION MEETINGS

All parents of children in Nursery to Higher Preparatory should have their appointments booked for Parent Consultation meetings next week. Each appointment slot is 10 minutes. In the evening sessions, there is a 5 minute gap between each appointment to allow for a change over. A bell will sound when appointments are ending and we do ask parents to try to help us keep to time. The locations of the meetings are as follows:

**Nursery:** Monday morning sessions will be in the Staff Study Room (just off the School Office). Tuesday and Thursday evening sessions will be in the Kindergarten classroom. Please wait in the Entrance Hall.

**Kindergarten:** All appointments will be in the Kindergarten classroom. Please wait on the chairs in the corridor by the Kindergarten cloakroom

**Lower Transition:** All appointments will be in the Lower Transition classroom. Please wait in the Entrance Hall. **Upper Transition:** All appointments will be in the Upper Transition classroom. Please wait on the chairs on the upstairs landing.

**Lower Preparatory:** All appointments will be in the Computing Room. Please wait on the chairs on the upstairs landing.

**Higher Preparatory:** All appointments will be in the Staff Study Room (off the School Office). Please wait in the Entrance Hall.

Books will be available in the Entrance Hall.
